**EXPERIENCE:** Preference may be given to applicants with life, student or teaching experiences; which provide them with the ability to teach community college students.

### GENERAL INFORMATION

The Yuba Community College District extends over 4,200 square miles, reaching from the foothills of the Sierra Nevada on the east to the Coast Range on the west, serving all or part of 8 counties in the north central part of the state.
